


JACKSON MEMORIAL PARK
SKATING RINK REGULATIONS

EFFECTIVE THIS DATE (12 January 1976), the following regulations to govern the use of the Jackson Memorial Park Skating Rink ARE ADOPTED by the Board of Selectmen, Town of Jackson and will be enforced by the Chief of Police, Town of Jackson.


1. Use of the rink is first and foremost for free/pleasure skating and such use WILL TAKE PRIORITY AT ALL TIMES.
2. NO HOCKEY GAMES or "puck shooting" or "practice" will be permitted without prior approval of the Board of Selectmen and the rink is reserved for such, except as indicated in Item 3, below.
3. "Puck shooting", "practice" and $\frac{1}{2}$ rink use hockey games are permitted under the following conditions ONLY:
 - a. There are fewer than 8 free skaters using the ice.
 - b. ONLY the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the rink is used.
 - c. Activity is confined to the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the rink and DOES NOT INTERFERE with free skating/skaters.
 - d. Net is removed from ice when activity is finished.
4. When KEEP OUT signs are posted, rink WILL NOT be used. Keep out signs will be posted only under following conditions:
 - a. Rink has been recently iced and ice has not yet set.
 - b. Ice is "rotten" or "dangerous".
 - c. Ice is being cleaned or repaired.
5. NO NIGHT SKATING is permitted unless rink lights are on. Rink lights are controlled by an automatic timer and turn off promptly at 10:00 P.M. THERE IS NO ADVANCE WARNING!
6. NO VEHICLES are permitted on the access road or in rink area.
7. NO ALCOHOLIC beverages are permitted on the rink or at rink side.
8. TRASH is to be deposited in containers provided.
