Susan and Paul reported on the meeting held with the Church Council on October 19. The purpose of the meeting was to update the Council on the proposed uses of and modifications to the library building. The Church Council clarified that a commercial use of the library building (such as art gallery) is potentially acceptable and would be determined on a case-by-case basis. The Council also reminded the Committee to take into account insurance requirements based on use of the building.
